TO THE PARENT'S OF OUR ADVENTURE WEEK CAMPERS:

We are very happy to confirm your child's enrollment for the 2009 camping season for the ONE-WEEK ADVENTURE CAMP at Red Oak. Like the day camp programs, we will be offering low ropes course, swimming, canoeing, tennis, field games, hiking, and archery, and more.

To participate in this program, we need the following forms:

- **The ACA Health and History Examination Form.** Please fill out this form and send it to Red Oak ASAP. We must have this form before your camper arrives in June. ***YOU DO NOT NEED A DOCTOR'S SIGNATURE FOR DAY CAMP ACTIVITIES. HOWEVER, IF YOU ARE GOING TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY RESIDENCE WEEK PROGRAMS, HAVE THE CAMPER HEALTH CARE RECOMMENDATIONS FORM COMPLETED BY A PHYSICIAN.*** Fax this information to **440-435-2774**.

Here is some other important information about this program:

- **Arrival/pickup time:** Please drop your campers off at Red Barn at 9:00 am, and pick them up at 4:00 p.m., at the Science Building Parking lot (I will be greeting parents there Monday morning). **IMPORTANT!!** No child will be allowed to leave camp except with his or her parents. Please send a note if child is to be picked up by someone else. Call the camp by 9 a.m. if child won't be in attendance for the day. - **Lunch:** You can pack a lunch and a drink, or you can buy lunch from camp for \$18.75 per week. Lunches are prepared in camp by our Camp Cook, Kandy Miller.
- **Equipment:** Campers should wear long pants and durable shoes. Also bring: swim suit and towel, sun block, flip flops for walking to the pool, extra change of clothes to leave for the week, and raincoat or poncho. We have lockers where campers can store these items. But please remember the camp has tennis rackets, swimming poles, bows and arrows, and other camping/sports equipment. No knives are allowed at camp.
- **Cell Phones and Electronics:** All cell phones will be confiscated by the Camp Director and held until the end of the day.
- **Emergencies:** In case of emergencies: In the event your camper is ill or injured, the Camp Director will contact you via the emergency numbers provided on the medical forms. If we cannot contact you within a reasonable period of time, as deemed necessary by the director depending on the nature of the illness or injury, we will contact the next person listed for contact on the medical form.
