

## BUS CONTRACT

### RED BARN AND CHINCAPIN BUS RULES

Please stay with your camper or car pool until the bus arrives in the a.m. If possible I will have a counselor there in the a.m. In the afternoon the bus will return to congregation Bethaynu at 4:35 and will wait until the last child is picked up.

Use this traffic pattern: **Enter the lot from Gates Mills Blvd. Exit the lot at Shaker Blvd.** Buses park toward the back of the lot. Use **EXTREME CAUTION AND CARE** when driving around the parking lot.

**Congregation Bethaynu asks that you do not park in restricted areas.** They have programs during the day and they want us to park toward the back of the lot by the buses. Keep away from the building as their patrons should be able to park by the building. The camp does not want to lose the privilege of using this lot.

**RULES:** The purpose of this letter is to bring to your attention how serious we are in maintaining control of the campers using the bus - not only for their safety but the sanity of our drivers. Please read this contract with your camper.

1. Remember, camp closes at 3 p.m. Fridays and bus returns at 3:35 p.m.
2. All hands, arms, legs, hats and any other body parts or objects in a bus riders' possession must remain inside the bus.
3. No throwing of any objects inside the bus or out of a window.
4. Normal talking and singing is allowed. Loud singing is not allowed.
5. Nothing is to be brought onto the bus without the approval of the bus driver. Fish or other wildlife should be left at camp.
6. You must remain seated and facing forward during the entire ride. (This is a state regulation).
7. The bus cannot stop to pick up a late rider.
8. Normal pick up in the morning is approximately 8:45 a.m. and leave by 8:55 a.m. and we return by 4:35 p.m. ON FRIDAY the return is one hour earlier (3:35 p.m.).
9. Follow any other rules that the counselors or bus drivers create for your safety and welfare.

If you (camper) cannot follow these rules, a counselor will give you a check mark. Three check marks in two weeks will result in a phone call to parents, at that time the proper discipline will be discussed.
