

## CHINCAPIN GENERAL INFORMATION

TOWN PEOPLE: Meet at Congregation Bethaynu, 27900 Gates Mills Blvd., Pepper Pike. Please observe the rules we have agreed to with them...**do not allow children to run around the parking lot or church grounds or in the building.** It is agreed that the children will stay in a quiet group with the car pool. **We like the privilege of using this parking lot.** Please park towards the rear of the lot near the buses. Important to be on time - please.

BETHAYNU GROUP: 8:35 A.M. Bus arrives at the parking lot. **MUST LEAVE AT 8:55!!**  
4:35 P.M. drop off

FRIDAY DROP OFF drop off one hour earlier 3:30

COUNTRY GROUP: families who will drive to camp.  
9:20 A.M. drop off camper at the barn  
4:00 P.M. pick up camper at the pool - off Baldwin Rd.  
3:00 P.M. **Friday** pick up at Pool

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PLEASE READ ALL THIS INFORMATION, THEN CALL IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS.

1. **IMPORTANT!!** No child will be allowed to leave camp except with her parents. Please send a note if child is to be picked up by someone else. Call the barn by 9 a.m. if child won't be in attendance for the day: **440-255-3309**. Call David Roskos, Director of the Camps evenings: **440-256-0716**. If you need to discuss personal issues regarding your child please call Tricia evenings at **440-466-9512**.
2. Transportation Delays/Changes: If for some reason (such as weather, mechanical failure, or other unforeseen event) we need to change pick up and drop off times, we will contact you via phone and email.
3. Car pools. If car pooling with 2 or more not of same family, campers and staff need the daily or weekly routine and driver's name. Send schedule on Monday so staff knows where child should go & with whom.
4. Unless campers choose the box lunch option, each camper brings her lunch every day. An insulated lunch box is best. We have a pop machine. I suggest you buy a plastic ice block to keep lunch cool.
5. Remember to order shirts and caps prior to the start of camp.
6. Girls should wear long pants for hikes, riding and Arb chores. Long pants protect legs from PI and insects. **RAIN COATS ARE A MUST!** Girls should leave at camp: swim suit, shorts, and a change of clothing (just in case!), rain coat or poncho, sunscreen, bug repellent (non spray type). Please send an OLD towel to camp and have her bring it home at least twice weekly to clean. **RIDING HELMETS ARE REQUIRED.**
7. On overnights she may bring a tent if she has one. Do not buy a tent. Bring sleeping bag and toilet articles. **MARK ALL ARTICLES...AND MARK THE OLD TOWELS SHE BRINGS TO CAMP.**
8. **No Cell Phones at Camp.** All cell phones will be confiscated by the Camp Director and held until the end of the day.
9. Notes from home: The staff needs the following examples of information:
  - Early pickup at camp. State time and review with camper.
  - No swimming? Please give reason and length of non-participation. He will still attend lessons at scheduled time, but not in the water.
  - Illness or injuries. State nature of illness or injury and wishes for activity limits. Such as no swimming, running etc. Also, if medication needed, please send note with instructions. I will dispense medications. In the event your camper is ill or injured, the Camp Director will contact you via the emergency numbers provided on the med forms.

10. **In case of emergencies:** In the event your camper is ill or injured, the Camp Director will contact you via the emergency numbers provided on the medical forms. If we cannot contact you within a reasonable period of time, as deemed necessary by the director depending on the nature of the illness or injury, we will contact the next person listed for contact on the medical form.
11. The resident week the girls will be living in the cabins at Red Oak. You will receive information regarding clothes and items needed for the weeks stay.
