



Regulations & Procedures

All participating members and groups of Red Oak camp are required to observe the following:

1. No smoking in any camp buildings or non-designated areas.
2. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are to be brought to or served in the camp.
3. No participants will be under the influence of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances.
4. No firearms, knives or weapons of any sort are permitted for use at or brought to camp.
5. No pets are permitted on Red Oak property.
6. Groups must inform Red Oak of their cell phone policy for minors.
7. The groups will be responsible for all emergency communication with participants' parents.
8. The group will distribute any over the counter or prescription medicines to its participants.
9. The group is responsible for emergency transportation of campers when seeking medical assistance.
10. Groups can use Red Oak's first aid supplies and available over the counter meds.
11. All group participants will remain within the boundaries of the campsite with the exception of emergency situations or program-organized activities.
12. Adult group representatives will be present with the group during the groups entire time period at camp.
13. No unscheduled visitors are permitted on the campgrounds. Permission from the camp Director must be secured in advance.
14. Group representatives are responsible for emphasizing and enforcing the observance of general safety concerns and rules.
15. All group participants are expected to behave in a manner that is not disruptive to the staff, program, facility, and other members of the group.
16. Everyone participating in boating, kayaking, or canoeing waterfront activities must wear a Personal Floation Device (PFD).
17. All pool areas may only be utilized at designated times when under the supervision of a Red Oak staff certified lifeguard.
18. All natural living things and animals are for the education and enjoyment of the Red Oak programs. All participants agree to respect nature and all Red Oak property.
19. All building and activity areas will be vacated as clean or better than, and in proper condition, as prior to the group's arrival. The designated group representative and Red Oak Program Director will review all necessary areas prior to the group's final departure.
20. Vehicle parking and usage is only permitted in designated areas. In camp vehicle usage is limited to approval by the Program Director. All vehicle operators will observe the posted 10 mph speed limit. No parking on grass unless otherwise instructed.
21. All participating group members will obey all the cabin rules as specified by the program director.

22. The group will assume full responsibility for and will compensate for any damages occurred by any and all group participants to Red Oak equipment or facility.
23. All participants must complete Red Oak's online program waiver, which will be used for emergency contact purposes by the group and for food and general allergy information.
24. All groups must receive a safety orientation, which is given by Red Oak's program director and staff at the beginning of each program. The orientation will describe usage rules and emergency procedures.
