WAIVER OF LIABILITY

There is inherent risk and danger in riding equines and similar animals ("horses") and engaging in related activities involving equines such as shows, trail rides, teaching, daily care and transportation. These risks include:

- (1) The propensity of a equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death or loss to persons on or around the equine;
- (2) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals;
- (3) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- (4) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person or an object;
- (5) The potential of a participant in an equine related activity to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

By signing this I recognize and understand the risks and dangers described above and hereby waive any claim against, and hereby release, each of Red Oak Camp, its trustees, its officers, its employees and its agents (each a "Released Party") with respect to any tort or other civil liability or obligation to the undersigned, or the heirs, successors and assigns of the undersigned arising out of or relating to the participation by (name of participant)
